

## Public Library Co-Design Coordinator (remote, Graduate Hourly)

Seeking an MSLIS student interested in public libraries, outreach, and community engagement to contribute to a research project funded by the Institute for Museum and Library Services. The MSLIS student will interface between public libraries and a research team led by Professor Jodi Schneider. The MSLIS student will help initiate and coordinate partnerships with 5 public libraries. Using insights from the team's research, the MSLIS student will recruit and work with public libraries to co-design example workshops and services that public libraries can use to support citizens and libraries. Examples would be workshops for librarians on "Teaching Lateral Reading Skills in Reference Interactions" or information literacy workshops for citizens on "How to be a Podcaster". Regular check-ins and attendance at weekly meetings are required. A positive attitude, spirit of advocacy, and a love of learning would be helpful.
